SANCERRE

Langlois Chateau, Chateau de Fontaine Audon **Sauvignon Blanc** 2019 \$ 75

Langlois Chateau is a producer based in the Loire Valley in France. It has been part of the Bollinger Group since 1972. They own a small Chateau in Sancerre, called Chateau de Fontaine-Audon, located in the north of the AOP Sancerre on "Silex" soils (flint).

Producing pure Sancerre Sauvignon from this estate, the wine is made exclusively in stainless steel and aged on lees for a few months before being released.

CHABLIS

Domaine Chanson Chablis Grand Cru Les Preuses Chardonnay 2017 \$ 197

Domaine Chanson is the oldest "Négociant" in Burgundy, established in 1750 in Beaune. Some of its earliest clients included Voltaire and even the young général Napoléon Bonaparte! Domaine Chanson owns a large parcel of its own vineyards in the Côte de Beaune, including some unique Premier Crus and Grand Crus, as well as it's négoce business (buying fruit from other regions like Chablis).

The Grand Cru Les Preuses is located on the northern end of the Grand Cru slope in Chablis, on pure Kimmeridgian chalk. Due to the southwesterly aspect, the vineyard produces rounder and softer wines compared to other Chablis Grand Crus. The wine is made in stainless steel tank and aged on lees for 12 months before bottling.

ALSACE

Domaine Marcel Deiss Burg

White Field Blend 2015

Jean-Michel Deiss is the strongest advocate of Terroir in Alsace. He has been making single vineyard, field blended wines since the early 1990s. The Burg vineyard is in their home village of Bergheim, in the heart of the Alsatian Grand Cru region, and is on rich and deep Keupar Marls. The grape varieties are mostly Gewurztraminer and Pinot Gris, along with smatterings of the other 11 grape varieties permitted in Alsace - feel free to google the names or to test our staff... The wine is made in large oak foudre, and fermentation is very slow (up to 12 months). This wine does have residual sugar, which adds to its mouthfeel.

A great Alsatian white wine!

Domaine Marcel Deiss Alsace Rouge

Red Field Blend 2020

Another wine from Domaine Marcel Deiss (see above), this is a very interesting Pinot Noir (95%) and Pinot Beurot, Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc blend (5%) from Alsace, from a very ripe and warm vintage. The fruit comes from various vineyards in Alsace that are mainly clay over limestone soils (like in Burgundy) in Bergeim, Beblenheim and Saint Hippolyte. The wine is fermented with 20% whole bunches and aged in a mixture of stainless steel (80%) and old barrels (20%) for a year.

With classic primary fruit flavours on the palate, you'll appreciate just how joyful this wine is!

BURGUNDY

Domaine Chanson Beaune 1er cru Clos des Marconnets

Pinot Noir 2019

This wine is from Domaine Chanson's own parcel of vines. The Clos des Marconnets is a great Premier Cru Pinot Noir vineyard in the north of the Beaune village, on higher ground. It shows great finesse and elegance, with ripe fruit flavours and a beautiful tannin structure. Fermented with 100% whole bunch and aged in oak barrels (25% new oak) for 12 months.

BORDEAUX

Pauillac de Lynch Bages Cabernet Merlot 2017

\$ 148

Lynch Bages is a 5th growth Bordeaux estate in Pauillac. It's top wine, Chateau de Lynch Bages, is one of the best value Chateau in the 1855 classification and some say it should be classified as a second growth. The Chateau has a second wine (Les Echos de Lynch Bages) and a third wine (Pauillac de Lynch Bages). 2017 was not the best vintage for Bordeaux, but Lynch Bages achieves a perfect expression of Pauillac "third wine" from the Chateau's younger vines. It is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (74%), Merlot (23%) and Cabernet Franc (3%). It's a wonderful introduction to the property, the young fruit character gives a forward, supple style that delivers delicious early drinking.
